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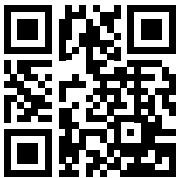

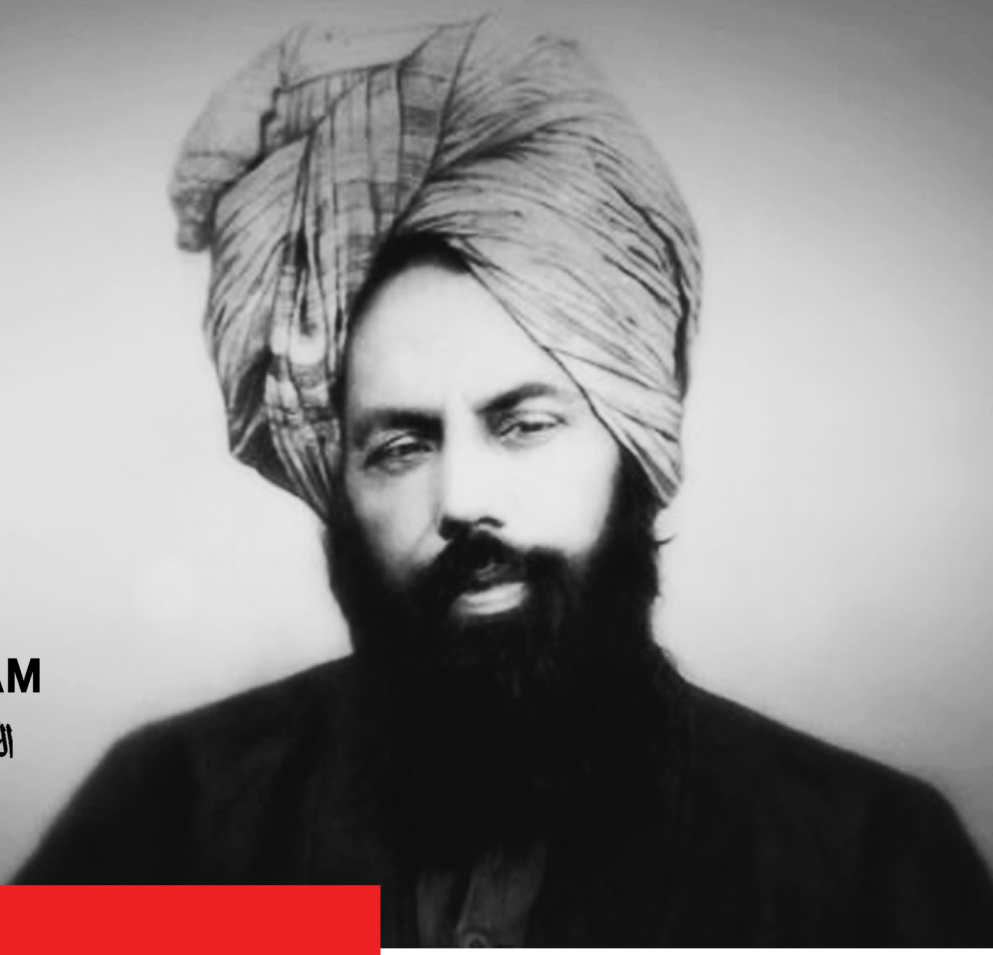


SAYINGS OF THE Holy Prophet (SAW)

“Ibn Is-haaq said, ‘Muhammad ibn Ja‘far ibn Az-Zubayr narrated that the (Najraan) delegation came to the Messenger of Allaah, sallallaahu ‘alayhi wa sallam, in Madeenah and entered his masjid wearing robes and garments after he had prayed the ‘Asr prayer. They accompanied a caravan of camels led by Bani Al-Haarith ibn Ka‘b. The Companions of the Messenger of Allaah who saw them said hat they never saw a delegation like them after that. When their time of worship came, they stood up to perform theirworship in the Prophet’s masjid. He, sallallaahu‘alayhi wa sallam, said, ‘Letthem (worship),’and they prayed towards the east.”

Continuing the historical narrative relating to the events around Taif, His Holiness drew lessons for today on moral leadership and the rule of law.



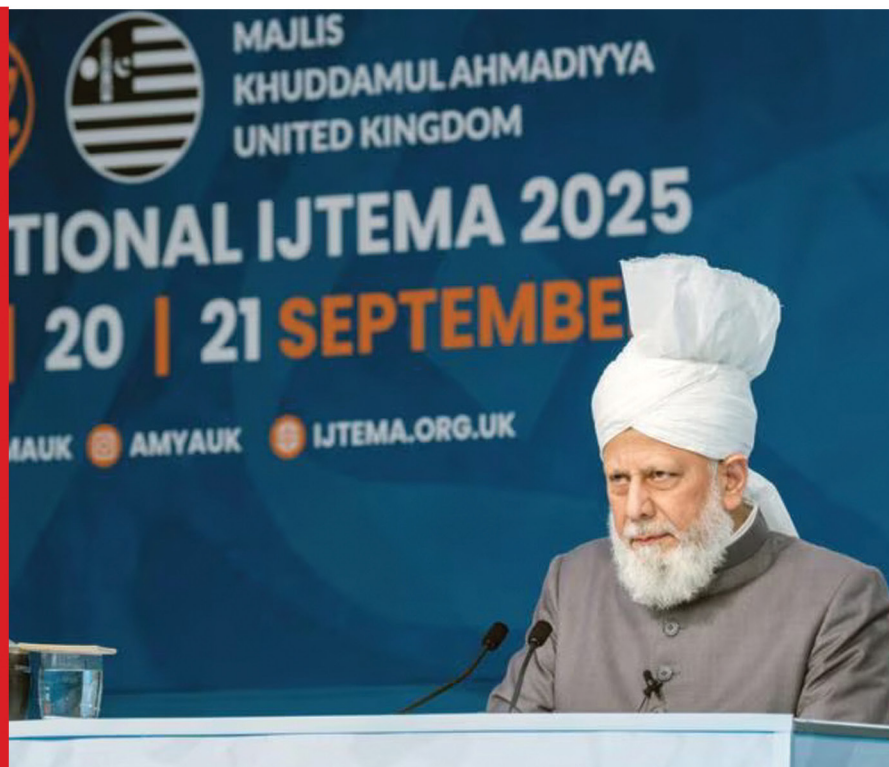

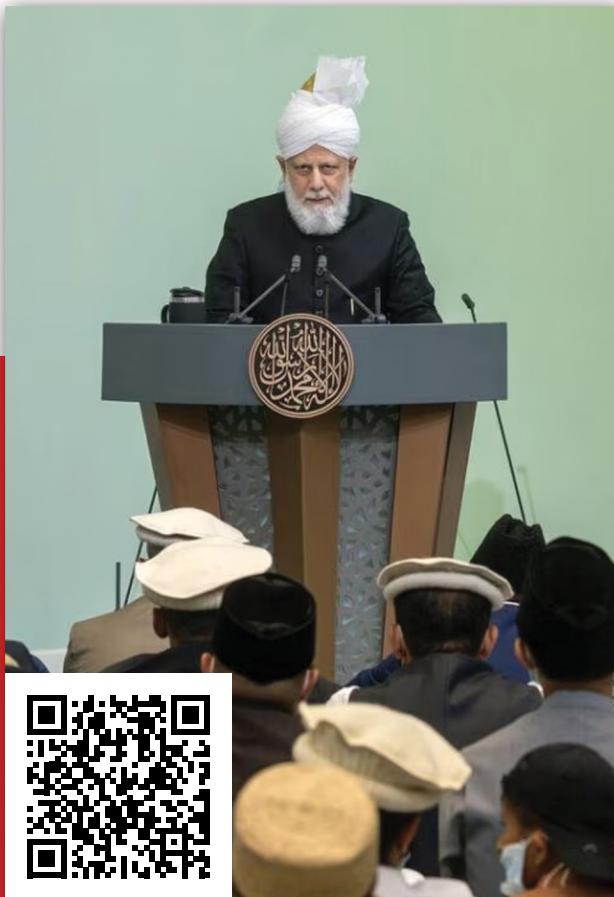
After reciting Tashahhud, Ta‘awwuz and Surah al-Fatihah, His Holiness, Hazrat Mirza Masroor Ahmad(aba) recited the following verse of the Holy Qur’an.

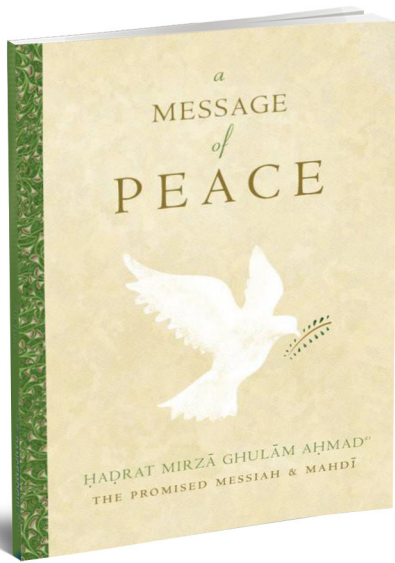
‘Verily, Allah enjoins justice, and the doing of good to others; and giving like kindred; and forbids indecency, and manifest evil, and wrongful transgression. He admonished you that you may take heed.’ (The Holy Qur’an, 16:91)

Following this, His Holiness(aba) stated that this verse is recited as the second sermon every Friday and on both occasions of Eid. In it, Allah the Almighty gives instructions on what one ought to do, and what one ought to abstain from. For a true believer to strengthen their faith, it is necessary for them to tread upon the commandments of Allah the Almighty, otherwise a Muslim cannot become a true believer.

In respect to the virtues mentioned in this verse, His Holiness(aba) said that he would mention what the Promised Messiah(as) has stated. The Promised Messiah(as) has mentioned these virtues from varying perspectives, ranging from the mutual relationships between humans to demonstrating justice, kindness and kinship with Allah the Almighty.

“The Promised Messiah(as) states that it is ordained by God that one should be just to Him and His creation, or in other words, fulfil their rights. If one can go beyond this, one should not only demonstrate justice, but also demonstrate kindness as though one truly perceives them. Furthermore, if one can go beyond this, then one should treat both God and His creation selflessly and with no expectation of recompense, similar to one who is selfless due to a relation.”
